ELEANOR EVERYWHERE was away alertly and set all of the pace, drew off through the stretch under heavy urging. SASSY AWARD was unhurried early, had a mild rally, but late. HIGH HOPES IRISH showed good early speed and pressed the pace, but then stopped. FLYING ROCKETTE was well placed, rallied, but failed to sustain a bid. SENSATIVE CINDY was void of early speed and passed tiring rivals, was no factor. KITTIWOOD showed brief speed then faded. FLIGHTY FORTY NINE was unhurried early but was no factor. ANOTHER TRY was in a good position in the middle of the pack, but bid, then hung. REGAL CHOICE dueled, inside, but was through after a half, then stopped. MAJESTIC PUMPKIN was well placed, but ran evenly, with no rally. TRACE OF CHARM was pinched back at the start and was pulled up.
