**Footnotes**

LEGENDARY PEACH stalked the pace on the outside while just in behind the dueling leaders, rallied on the turn, drew clear late under constant handling. BANNERSTONE dueled for the lead on the inside early, weakened in the stretch but was still second best. POWER SERGE was void of early speed, had a late rally on the outside and was gaining but too late. BOONE'S DAD was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly throughout and had no rally. SECOND SHIFT set the pace while racing just off the rail, was through after a half mile and faded in the stretch. LA PRADA was well placed early on the outside in mid pack, had no rally. HALF OFF was no factor and showed little. MICHEL WITH ONE L was well placed while saving ground, had no rally or excuse.
