TROUTDALE stalked the pace from the outside, rallied on the turn and into the stretch, wore down the leaders and drew clear late under firm handling. DANGEL dueled for the lead and prompted the pace, took the lead on the turn and led to mid stretch, faltered but was still second best. HOUND TOR was unhurried early, rallied into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. HOUSEBUILDER was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly with nor rally. JUST DAZZLING was no factor but did improve position. IAIN'TMADATCHA was no factor. AWSOME RICHIE set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. COME ON GARCON bobbled at the start, flashed brief speed before stopping. SLEWBISCUIT failed to menace.
