TIPPA TIPPA TAE dueled for the lead from the outside, fought gamely and drew clear, was all out late to hold on. OUR SHE DEVIL stalked the pace from mid pack, rallied on the outside, found her best stride late and was gaining. WOLF GIRL dueled for the lead from the inside, weakened in the stretch but gave way grudgingly. TARAN T. stalked the pace while never far back, ran evenly and had no rally. STEEPED was void of early speed, had a late rally and was gaining. SHE'S A NICE COLOR was unhurried early, had a steady advance but was gaining too late. PRADA was unhurried early, had a mild rally but was not a factor. GOLD IDEA failed to menace. SPOKEN FOR stalked the pace mid pack but had no rally. TRUMP PRINCESS was no factor. NEVA FAY showed good early speed but was through after a half mile and dropped back.
