Footnotes

JUICY POINT was unhurried early on the inside, rallied on the second turn and was steadied while awaiting room, got through along the rail and drew off under firm handling. SOCKS stalked the pace while never far back and then dueled for the lead, could not go with the winner in the stretch but was clearly second best. DAKOTA MAX set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. FLAMING ARROWS was in a good stalking position, rallied on the far turn, failed to sustain the bid and faded in the stretch, bled after the race. LE ROI was void of early speed, rallied on the far turn, had a middle move and ran evenly late. PA KETTLE failed to menace.
