CLICK ON SLEET set the pace to the turn while saving ground, responded when challenged in the stretch, came again gamely and was all out to hold sway late. DASHING GIRL stalked the pace while never far back on the outside, rallied into the stretch while wide, drifted through the stretch and lacked a closing response. HEIGHT ROLLER was unhurried early on the outside, rallied in the stretch and was gaining but too late. WAR TUNES dueled for the lead from the outside, rallied on the turn and took the lead, drifted out in the stretch and weakened. PAINT THE WIND was in a good stalking position on the inside, rallied into the stretch, flattened out and ran evenly late. HIGH RHODE was well placed on the outside in mid pack, rallied in the stretch, lacked a late response and began to fade. FATIMA'S GOLD was no factor and showed little. NAHAR failed to menace. GIVING was not a threat.
