SEEN DANCING perfectly placed behind the two leaders to the turn, drove past entering the stretch and held sway in the drive under good handling. DEVINE FORCE alternated for the lead to deep stretch but could not hold off the charging winner in the final stages and gamely held the place spot. ELLIE GEE alternated for the lead to deep stretch but faltered in the late going. FLIP SIDE broke a bit awkward with no speed to the stretch and moved up through the drive. CAT'S FORTY raced evenly inside, was in tight through late stretch and steadied. WHITEWATER WAY raced evenly and failed to respond when needed while racing widest through the stretch run. LACY BY DESIGN never far back and lacked a late response. TIGER'S REIGN raced in contention for a half and dropped back thereafter.
