SILVER DIGGER stalked the pace while saving ground, rallied into the turn and drew off in upper stretch, was all out to hold sway late. MAGIC PEGGY was well placed in mid pack, rallied into the stretch, flattened out and ran evenly late. STARTING GUN dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, was forced wide on the turn, weakened in the stretch and began to fade. WEATHER HEATHER was unhurried early, was wide on the turn and lost ground, had a mild late rally while wide. POLLY PEPPERSTONE was void of early speed while wide and lost ground, had a mild late rally. GALLOWAY dueled for the lead and set the pace, bore out entering the turn, gave way in the stretch.
