BLUSHING HATTIE stalked the pace while saving ground, rallied on the turn but was steadied on the rail while in tight, came again in the stretch, drew clear late under heavy pressure. ZANNY'S DANCER was pinched back at the start, was rushed up and duelled for the lead, took command and drew clear, could not go with the winner but was clearly second best. TIC TIC TIC was void of early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining. SHIVALRIE was away alertly and set the pace to upper stretch, faltered in the drive and faded late. SOMMERGATE was no factor and showed little. KITTIWOOD showed brief speed on the backstretch but then faded thereafter. MISS DUSTY duelled for the early lead, was through after a half mile and dropped back.
