**Footnotes**

CITIZEN JOHN stalked the pace with good early speed while off the rail, rallied on the far turn and drew off in upper stretch, was all out to hold the margin late. IT'S ALL ABOUT JOY was unhurried early, had a steady advance towards the front, rallied too late in the stretch and was gaining but too late. GYPSY WIND stalked and pressed the pace while off the rail, led on the backstretch and drew clear on the far turn, weakened late and began to fade. BIG ROCKIN' DADDY was well placed early, rallied on the far turn, failed to sustain the bid and dropped back in the stretch. FLYING WARRIOR stalked and pressed the pace, faltered on the second turn and faded in the stretch. CLIFF DIVIN was no factor but did improve position. ROM BABA was off slowly and spotted the field several lengths, failed to menace. MT. ORIENT set the pace with good early speed, stopped and dropped back. CAPTAIN BRY was no threat. NOROAMIN was well placed in mid pack, had no rally.
