Footnotes

CYBERFLASH showed good early speed, took a clear lead into the stretch with rider putting his stick away at the eighth pole then held on under good handling late. DOOZE chased the winner throughout, made a run through the stretch but could not get past late. BEACH COMMANDER never far back, came five wide into the stretch with no late gain in the drive. STARSHIP SUPREME could not keep up early, raced evenly and lacked the late response needed in the lane. NAPOLEON J not far back early, floated widest into the turn while no threat. KEEP SAM IN CHEQ was no factor with an inside trip. TRACKS SO SWEET threw his head after the start and was never a menace. DISCO JOHN was never a threat.
