RADIO BALL was void of early speed, rallied on the far turn and closed with a rush, drew clear in upper stretch, was under constant pressure to the finish. LUCKY SAVANAH dueled for the lead and set the pace while saving ground, could not go with the winner in the stretch but was second best. SNEAKY SULLIVAN pressed the pace and dueled for the lead from the outside, gave way in the stretch and dropped back. POE REEF was unhurried early, rallied on the backstretch, failed to sustain the bid and dropped back in the stretch. DIABLO CITO was no threat. CHASE THE BLAZE stalked the pace while up close to the far turn, faltered in the stretch and faded. T J'S POPEYE failed to menace.
