Footnotes

MAJOR KEENE was unhurried early while five wide, had a steady advance towards the front, rallied into the stretch and dueled, drew off late under firm handling. HALF LOADED was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain but too late. SAINT HUBERT stalked and pressed the pace from the outside, rallied and drew off on the far turn, led into the stretch and then weakened late. COACHTHECHIP was void of early speed, rallied into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. RAGPICKER'S SAINT was in a good stalking position and showed good early speed, ran evenly with no rally. PHIL C was no factor, passed tiring rivals. SWINGN SLEW bobbled at the start, dueled for the lead and set the pace, was through after a half mile, gave way and dropped back. ESPRESSO JOE dueled for the lead and set the pace, gave way and dropped back. KEENUS FROM LOUISA flashed brief speed before stopping.
