NATIVE CRY dueled for the lead and prompted the pace from the outside, was allowed to settle on the turn, rallied into the stretch and drew off under constant handling. IRISH MORNING dueled for the lead and set the pace, weakened in the stretch but was still second best. MADE FOR A MISSION was unhurried early while wide and lost ground, improved position but was no threat to the top two. PICKLES bobbed and bore in at the start, was rushed up and dueled, was used up and dropped back. HARRY CANARY bobbed at the start and failed to menace. DONTLOOKMEOVER showed good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back. DOC MILL was pinched back at the start, flashed brief speed before fading. CASTLE STORM was unhurried early while eight wide and lost ground, had no rally.
