TWOSTEP PARTNER stalked the pace while never far back, rallied on the far turn and took the lead, was all out to prevail in a long drive. HOWDY BOY RIB was unhurried early, rallied into the stretch and dueled for the lead, could not go with the winner but gave way grudgingly. CRYPTEEZE stalked the pace while never far back, ran evenly with no rally. WANNABETHEBISCUIT set the pace with good early speed, gave way and dropped back. HEAD TO TOE was no factor. S R KING OF QUEENS failed to menace.
