FORMAL ARRANGEMENT unhurried early, rallied to leader three wide, gained the lead and drew clear then held well in the final stages. PART GIRLIE GIRL just off the leaders while inside to the stretch, gained a short lead between calls around the final turn, hooked by the winner into the stretch, battled with that one while drifting out through the final stages in a game effort. GOT BLING stumbled badly at the start, had no speed, moved up late while no threat to the top pair. DINKERS IDOL showed good speed to set the pace for a half and weakened thereafter. CINCY GIRL raced evenly for three quarters and gave way. HEATHER TIME failed to menace. POLLY PEPPERSTONE raced close to the pace for a half but dropped far back in the stretch while being eased in the final furlong. HOUSTON HEIST broke sharp, raced three wide around the first turn but had her bridle break down the backstretch and was pulled up.
