STORM TURTLE stalked the pace while never far back, rallied on the far turn and into the stretch, drew clear late under firm handling. SLEW'S BAD BOY set the pace with good early speed, weakened in the stretch but was second best. COACHTHECHIP was in a good stalking position, rallied into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. SAAR was well placed in mid pack, ran evenly and had no rally. DRAKE MANOR failed to menace. AUSTIN ECHO was no factor. MR. RAVEN showed good early speed, gave way and dropped back. HARDBOOT was no threat.
