TOCA ARAKEN was unhurried early, had a steady advance to the lead, challenged in upper stretch and drew clear in mid stretch, was fully extended to the wire. BELIEVE IT TO GO stalked the pace while never far back, rallied into the stretch but could not go with the winner after the rider had his whip knocked from his right hand in the drive but was clearly second best. JES TJ was away alertly and dueled for the lead, weakened in the stretch, gamely held the show. DECIBALL was void of early speed, ran evenly and had no rally. LIBITO POINT was well placed in the middle of the pack, rallied into the stretch but was steadied when the hole closed up in upper stretch, finished well thereafter. A'S AN B'S flashed brief speed but then gave way and faded. IRGEE dueled for the lead setting fast fractions, stopped and faded.
