JUST CALL'ER was away alertly and set all of the pace while off the rail, drew off in upper stretch and was fully extended to the wire. LIVE TODAY was in a good stalking position in mid pack, improved position but was no threat to the winner. HONEY C was void of early speed, had no rally or excuse. MAZEY TWEENNEY showed good early speed chasing the pace, faltered and faded. THIS IS MY CASE was pinched back at the start, improved position but was no threat. GIVEMENOBULL dwelt and then was nine and lost ground. SLAM BEST flashed brief speed before stopping. IRON BABY ANGEL failed to menace. HAUNTED WOODS showed good early speed dueling for the lead, was used up and dropped back.
