Footnotes

SARAH JANE was unhurried early while racing along the hedge, was angled out and rallied into the stretch, bore out nearing the wire and bumped foe in a driving finish. LUVAPRIVATE was well placed on the outside in mid pack, rallied in the stretch and was gaining, was bumped by foe nearing the wire. TOMMEYESGOLD was in a good stalking position on the outside early, rallied on the far turn and loomed boldly, ran evenly through the stretch and lacked a closing response. FIGHT GIRL pressed the pace with good early speed, was seven wide on the first turn and lost ground, rallied on the second turn and vied for the lead, weakened in the stretch and began to fade. QUIETMYDEAR was unhurried early on the outside, rallied on the far turn, failed to sustain the bid and faded in the stretch. MONEY CARD duelled for the lead and set the pace from the outside, faltered in the stretch and dropped back. SILKY TAB was unhurried early on the inside, improved position in the stretch but was no factor. DONAMOUR pressed the pace from between with good early speed, gave way on the far turn and dropped back. DEVILISH CANDY set the pace while saving ground, bore out entering the first turn, gave way after a half mile and dropped back. COAX ME HEIDI was no factor and showed little.
