Footnotes

DIALING DELEMA stalked the pace while never far back, rallied on the turn and took the lead entering the stretch, drew off through the stretch under pressure. DIXIE TEMPO bore out at the start, rallied on the turn but then failed to sustain her bid in the stretch. CHEROKEE RAIN was steadied soon after the start, was steadied again entering the turn while in tight, was angled out on the turn and improved position but was not a factor. PASSMELUCK was unhurried early, improved position but was not a factor. EASTER VIOLET was well placed in the middle of the pack, rallied on the turn and then flattened out in the stretch. PRINCESS SHELBY was away alertly and set the pace while racing off the rail, gave way in the stretch and dropped back. MODEL'S BIG FOUR stalked the pace from mid pack evenly and had no rally. SUMMER GIRL failed to menace. MUSICAL GENIUS showed good early speed but stopped on the turn and faded. JINGLE JANGLE MISS flashed brief speed and then stopped on the turn.
