CLECO dueled for the lead and pressed the pace from the inside, drew off in upper stretch, was all out to hold the margin late. LADY LIKES THREES pressed the pace and dueled for the lead from the outside, rallied in the stretch but found her best stride late and was gaining. SKY BRIDE was well placed in mid pack, had a mild rally in the stretch and some late gain, but too late. MISS LOLA'S NOTE was bumped at the start, was void of early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. GOUGE showed good early speed chasing the pace from the inside, had no rally. CHARMING ANNA dueled for the lead and pressed the pace from the outside, faltered in the stretch and faded. FOR ALL OF US was unhurried early on the inside, had no rally. FOREVER VICTORIOUS bore out and bumped foe at the start, was no threat.
