LITTLE JO BROLLY stalked the leader for three quarters, took over into the stretch and drew off through the final furlong while drifting out late. GAMBLER'S HONOUR unhurried early, made a steady advance outside bid through the stretch but was no match while out in the center of the course. R. HAROLD reserved early, moved five wide around the final turn and rallied for show. TRADEWATER PIRATE had no speed for a half, rallied inside through the stretch run while no real threat. QUINTANA ROO raced evenly and lacked a late response. CATCHING THE SUN sprinted to a clear lead from outside, stayed clear for three quarters and gave way readily through the stretch from inside. AISLE RACER was through after a half. MAINLY'S GIANT was through early. ROCK N GROHL was never a factor.
