SUNSTRUCK squeezed early, forced the pace, took over into the stretch run, drew clear through the final furlong and held while all out. SILVER DIGGER never far back, rallied four wide around the turn and was slowly gaining too late. WHAT'S LEFT bore in at the start and bumped rival, made a bid into the stretch but flattened out in the drive. MY LITTLE CONTESSA unhurried early and only improved position late. CAT ZONE showed good speed from outside to duel for a half and gave way thereafter. FRENCH NATIVE was never a threat. LOLLICAT came out at the start slamming rival and was through after a half. POLITICIANS DREAM bumped at the start and was never close. ALYCHANCE was through early. WIN D TWO had good position for a half and faded. MAMBO WONDER was slammed hard after the start and never recovered.
