BUSHA' was pinched back at the start, was in a good stalking position in mid pack, rallied into the stretch and split horses in upper stretch, was under firm handling to the finish. ALMIGHTY O stalked and pressed the pace, took the lead on the far turn could not go with the winner late and gave way grudgingly. NEHRU was well placed while saving ground, rallied on the far turn and loomed a threat, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late while in tight along the hedge. TSUNAAMI STU was void of early speed, had a mild late rally and some late gain. MY BEST CHANCE was in a good stalking position and showed good early speed, weakened in the stretch and began to fade. THATS A HECKOFACAT bore out at the start, set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. BABA BOOEY failed to menace. OH AGE EYE OH was no factor. GAMBLEFORMONEY was no factor.
