Footnotes

POTENTIAL was unhurried early on the inside, rallied into the stretch and was angled out, drew off late under constant pressure. HOUSEBUILDER was well placed on the inside, rallied into the stretch and loomed a threat, could not go with the winner but was second best. SUPER WHIPPER bobbled at the start and then was rushed up, rallied into the stretch, hung in the stretch and ran evenly late. MOON IS A STAR was in a good stalking position, rallied on the turn, gave way and dropped back. MUCH TO DO failed to menace. DYNOMIGHTRUNAWAY set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded.
