### Footnotes

IDE RATHER BE WILD dueled for the lead and set the pace while saving ground, rallied on the turn and was headed in the stretch, came again late and was all out to get up in time. MYHEART'SRESERVED was unhurried early, rallied on the far turn and dueled led in late stretch and was badly outfinished to the wire. QUEEN IMIDALA stalked the pace while never far back while on the inside, rallied into the stretch, flattened out and ran evenly late. BLIND AS A BAT was unhurried early, improved position but was no factor. SALLY'S LAST ONE failed to menace. PRIZE FEVER showed good early speed chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back.
