WEATHER HEATHER was in a good stalking position in mid pack, rallied into the stretch on the outside, drew clear late under constant urging. MYHYMILLIE showed good early speed chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back, gamely held the place. SHEZA SPEEDY duelled for the lead and pressed the pace, weakened in the stretch and began to fade. MISS HOT LUCK set the pace with good early speed, faltered in the stretch and ran evenly late. WIN D TWO showed good early speed while up close, gave way and dropped back. CHUCKS A DEVILGIRL showed good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back. POLLY PEPPERSTONE was well placed early, weakened and dropped back. LITTLE MARILYN failed to menace.
