OLIVER'S COVE stalked the pace from between horses early, rallied on the second turn, could not get to the winner but gamely held the place. JUICY POINT was in a good stalking position, rallied into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. TENMOR was no factor and showed little. CAME AND GONE dueled for the lead and set the pace, faltered and faded. HE'S A BIG DADDY failed to menace.
