WINDY SPRUCE bore out and bothered foe at the start, stalked the pace just behind the dueling leaders, was in tight and steadied entering the stretch, dueled for the lead in the stretch, bore out and bothered foe in late stretch, was all out to just last to hold on for the dead heat. COSMIC SECRETS was unhurried early, rallied on the outside, wore down the leaders and was all out to gamely get up in the final strides. GITSUMYONDER stalked and pressed the pace, rallied into the stretch and took the lead, was taken up when foe bore out, continued gamely to the finish. L'OHIO stalked the pace from the middle of the pack, ran evenly and had no rally but did improve position. SEMINOLE SHOE stalked the pace from the middle of the pack, ran evenly and had no rally. CALL ME REBECCA showed good early speed but was through after a half mile and stopped. ISLAND SPRING dueled for the lead from the inside, was through after a half mile and stopped. ELS BELLE was no factor and showed little. MAYBETHEONE was no factor and was eased.
