COPPER SUNSHINE showed good early speed, while racing inside, got through along the rail mid stretch, was all out to wire. DREAMS COUNT was never far back, checked repeatedly while behind horses on the turn, was in tight mid stretch, angled out and was gaining with every stride. SYDNEY'S MAJESTY dueled between horses and gained command, but weakened late stretch. BURN AND BEGONE was five wide and lost ground, was steadied mid stretch, improved position late. BLUSHING JABAR was well placed between horses, rallied, but lacked late response. AUNT JACK was four wide, rallied, but flattened out.
