A LOT OF TRY was well placed in mid pack while on the outside, rallied on the far turn and took command entering the stretch, was fully extended to add to the margin late. WHITEWATER WAY was void of early speed while on the inside, rallied into the stretch and loomed boldly, flattened out and ran evenly late. LADY LILEAH pressed the pace and then dueled for the lead, led to upper stretch, weakened in the drive and began to fade late. ALMOST DISSUADED was unhurried early on the inside, improved position in the stretch but was not a threat. UMMUMMGOOD was in a good stalking position in mid pack, rallied on the second turn, failed to sustain the bid in the stretch and dropped back. SAND AND FIGHT was no factor but did improve position. MISS SWISS APPEAL showed good early speed while chasing the pace on the outside, gave way on the second turn and faded in the stretch. DEAR SARA failed to menace. GLORYS GOTCHA showed good early speed, was through after a half mile and dropped back thereafter. MAJESTIC LEGS was up close for the first half mile, gave way and dropped back.
