RED BRICK AVENUE was allowed to set the slow pace while saving ground, responded when asked on the final turn, drew off under firm handling. STARRY MARK was well placed in mid pack early, rallied on the far turn and loomed boldly, flattened out in the stretch and ran evenly late. OVERCAME was pinched back at the start when forced in, improved position in the stretch but was no threat. SAVANNAH'S PRIZE was void of early speed, ran evenly throughout but did improve position. MAID'S FOLLY was unhurried early while wide on the turns and lost ground, rallied on the second turn and loomed boldly, flattened out in the stretch and dropped back. PHARLY'S WARS stalked and pressed the pace from the outside, drifted out in the stretch and finished mid track. NEW MIRACLE was in a good stalking position early, ran evenly and had no rally. BROCCO BABY flashed brief speed while up close early, gave way and dropped back. WAVERLY GOLD bore in at the start and bothered foe, was no factor.
