### Footnotes

QUICK GIN FIZZ stalked the pace with good early speed on the inside, rallied on the turn and into the stretch, drew off late under heavy pressure. LADY CAPES was unhurried early, rallied into the stretch and loomed a threat, flattened out and ran evenly late. SEATTLE RISING was void of early speed, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. LILY'S FLOWERY set the pace with good early speed, faltered and faded. BELLE N' BLACKIE was well placed while four wide, rallied on the turn and loomed boldly, failed to sustain the bid and faded in the stretch. PRETTY PERKY PATTI showed good early speed while four wide, had no rally. JOHNA'S HOPE failed to menace. IRENE THE BIG ONE was no factor.
