FINGER TAPPING stalked the pace while never far back and saving ground, rallied on the far turn and got through along the rail, was fully extended to add to the margin late. TICONDERO set the pace with good early speed, weakened in the stretch but was second best. NATIVE YELL lunged at the start, was well placed in mid pack, rallied on the far turn and loomed a threat, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. PLEASANTLY WILD dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, faltered and faded. GOT SEOUL failed to menace. NEVER FORGET showed good early speed chasing the pace, rallied on the far turn, failed to sustain the bid and dropped back. JUST YOU AND I KID was no factor. SEISMOGRAPHER was off slowly and was no threat.
