

SNEAK A COLD TREAT was well placed early, was steadied on the first turn, rallied on the second turn, hung and dropped back. RAISE THE REWARD was in a good stalking position and showed good early speed, gave way and dropped back. THATS A HECKOFACAT was unhurried early, improved position but was no factor. WHERESTHELIMIT showed good early speed chasing the pace, gave way and dropped back. TRIPLE GLORY was steadied while in tight on the first turn,
