SAFARI DREAM was unhurried early while five wide, rallied into the stretch, began to draw clear late while drifting out. AWESOME PLAY stalked the pace while never far back, rallied into the stretch and drew clear, weakened and ran evenly late. SMART REASON was well placed and showed good early speed, rallied into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. FRENCH SADIE was unhurried early while saving ground, rallied into the stretch, was checked repeatedly while awaiting room, had some late gain. OUTLAW LOVER dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, faltered and faded. SHELIA was no factor, ran evenly with no rally. JULESNOMENCLATOR dueled for the lead and set the pace, gave way and dropped back. SYBLES ANGEL showed good early speed, weakened and faded.
