IRISH BRIDE was well placed, rallied, gained command, was under heavy urging to the line. REGENCY ROAD raced in a good position, rallied, but lacked a late response. BREEZEONBYUM was unhurried early, saved ground, rallied, but had to altered course late to avoid tiring foe. CRUELLA DE VIL set the early pace with good early speed, but stopped badly late stretch. IF YOU TWO was void of early speed, had a mild rally, but late. FLUFFY'S BEST good position, raced evenly with no rally. WHITE HALL DOVE was well placed, had a mild rally, but late. MIDNIGHT SILK was well placed, was through after a half and stopped. MARY CAHILL'S RIB brief speed, stopped. DREAM SELECTION had a good position, was through after a half and gave way. MY VOODOO PRINCESS was no factor, showed little. PEROXIDE 'N PAINT had good early speed and gave way.
