Footnotes

THIS IS MY CASE was unhurried early while saving ground, rallied into the stretch and got through along the rail, drew clear late under firm handling. WAHL OF FAME duelled for the lead and pressed the pace, drew clear on the turn, was under constant urging to the wire. PERSEVERE was unhurried early on the inside, had a late rally in the stretch and was gaining but too late. SOGNI D'ORO was void of early speed, improved position in the stretch but was no factor. FLEA MARKET showed good early speed chasing the pace, faltered and faded. WHAT ZONE duelled for the lead and set the pace, gave way and dropped back. TROUBLE CROWN flashed brief speed before stopping.
