JUICY POINT was unhurried early while in between horses, rallied into the stretch and split horses, drew off late under constant urging. GREENHILL CHARLIE stalked the pace with good early speed while four wide, rallied on the far turn, could not get to the winner but held the place. PANDA set the pace with good early speed while off the rail, weakened in the stretch and began to fade. WEEKEND WONDER was unhurried early, rallied on the far turn, failed to sustain the bid and dropped back. BEHREN'S LEGACY was well placed while five wide, rallied on the second turn, hung and dropped back. HUM THAT TUNE failed to menace.
