**Footnotes**

NAEVUSHKA stalked the pace while never far back, rallied on the far turn and drew clear, had a clear lead into the stretch, was all out to just last. HOPEWEBREAKEVEN was in a good stalking position in mid pack, rallied into the stretch, found his best stride late and was gaining. CHA CHA BROWN showed good early speed, was forced wide on the first turn when ANOTHER REASON bore out entering the turn, was steadied entering the far turn, came again in the stretch and was gaining but too late. RIGHT HERE was well placed in mid pack, improved position in the stretch but was no threat. CELEBRITY BALL was void of early speed, improved position in the stretch but was no factor. DELUNE was in a good stalking position in mid pack, had no rally. FOR ALL OF US showed good early speed chasing the pace, gave way in the stretch and dropped back. ANOTHER REASON showed good early speed, bore out entering the first turn and caused a chain reaction, gave way and faded. JEZZABELLE BROWN was no factor and showed little. GOUGE showed good early speed, was forced wide and steadied entering the first turn, weakened. POCKET MEDUSA was forced wide entering the first turn and stayed wide throughout and lost ground, was no factor.
