FAX A FREDDY had good early speed, dueled for the lead and drew clear, drew off under urging through the lane. GOLDEN DINNER was unhurried early, had a late rally and was gaining. DREAMS COUNT was well placed, rallied, but was no match for winner. MR. BIGGLESWORTH was in a good position, rallied, but flattened out. OLD SNIVELY pressed the pace while racing inside, but stopped. SHOULDSTAYEDATWORK broke in the air and was no factor. MCKINLEY RHODES had good early speed, was through after a half and stopped. SULTAN'S GOLD was no factor, showed little.
