LADY ARIEL was unhurried early while six and seven wide and lost ground, rallied into the stretch and wore down the leaders, drew clear under constant handling. LOLLICAT dueled for the lead and set the pace while on the outside, rallied on the turn and drew clear, could not go with the winner late but was second best. SUN BOLT pressed the pace with good early speed, weakened on the turn and faded through the stretch. BELLE'S LIL STAR was void of early speed, improved position in the stretch but was no threat to the top two. ALYCHANCE was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly and had no rally. LADY THUNDER was no factor but did improve position. MISS HOT LUCK dueled for the lead with good early speed, gave way and dropped back. MAMBO WONDER flashed brief speed before stopping.
