BE A BIDDER sat just off leaders to the turn, rallied through the stretch off the rail and ran past the leader to draw clear late. SMART SENZA had good speed to battle on the front end, could not last but bested the rest. FOGGYSTATEOFMIND raced inside most of way and failed to respond in the drive. PHIL'S BOY raced evenly but lacked a late response when needed. CASTLE STORM never a real factor. BRASSTOWN SHERIFF was no threat. SWEPT ON SUNDAY secured good position, came with a five wide bid at the quarter pole but stopped badly through the stretch run. ULTRA PETE was through early.
