HOT N CODE was well placed, had a late rally, and was gaining. A SPECIAL HELLO was well placed, rallied, but flattened out. NORTHERN CHARMER had good early speed, but gave way, dropped back. GULLEY set the pace with good early speed, gave way second turn. FE STAR SONG was void of early speed, had a mild rally, late. RENTRAG was in a good position but raced evenly with no rally. ROAD TO ROYALTY failed to menace. TAMMANY HALL was no threat. CHANNEL VISION failed to menace.
