STAN C LISA stalked the pace while never far back, rallied on the far turn and took the lead, drew off in upper stretch and was under heavy pressure to add to the margin late. STORMYS PROCLIVITY set the pace with good early speed, weakened in the stretch but was still second best. STRICKLY MARLA dueled for the lead and pressed the pace, gave way and dropped back. TECH NO PRISONERS was off slowly, was unhurried early, improved position but was no factor. REGAL WONDER failed to menace. NEWFOUND STAR showed good early speed, faltered and faded. LIGHT EVENT was no threat.
