QUITE A PARTY stalked the pace to the outside of the pacesetter, rallied on the far, drew off in the stretch under constant handling. LIGHT ON HER TOES was unhurried early on the outside, rallied into the stretch after being taken to the rail, was all out to just get up for the place. JOANAIR was well placed in mid pack on the outside in mid pack, rallied into the stretch, flattened out and ran evenly late. ZOE IN RED was in a good stalking position on the outside in mid pack, rallied on the second turn, failed to sustain the bid in the stretch and faded. THIS TRAIN was void of early speed, improved position in the stretch but was no factor. SWING ON was unhurried early, passed tiring ones but was no factor. MY ALLEY CAT set the pace with good early speed, faltered in the stretch and faded. T O'S QUARTERBACK was pinched back at the start, was no factor. MAE FORCES showed good early speed chasing the pace, gave way in the stretch and dropped back. REAL STUFF was in a good stalking position, had no rally. SKIDDY bore in at the start and bothered foe, was up close early, gave way on the backstretch and faded thereafter.
