DONT POKE THE BEAR stalked the pace while never far back, was checked going into the first turn, rallied on the far turn and took over in the stretch, drew off and was fully extended to hold the margin late. BELGRAVE SQUARE was unhurried early while saving ground, rallied on the far turn and was steadied while being angled out, had a late rally and was gaining but too late. THE REDFOX set the pace with good early speed while off the hedge, weakened in the stretch and ran evenly late. MORE THAN OVER was in a good stalking position in mid pack, ran evenly and had no rally. INDY GO SUN was unhurried early, rallied into the stretch and loomed a threat, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. NEW DIVA stalked the pace, was steadied entering the first turn, had good early speed, faltered and faded. ONETWENTYONE TRACK showed good early speed, was steadied entering the first turn, gave way and dropped back. DRAKE MANOR failed to menace. MEPHISTOPHELES trailed and was no threat.
