SILKY TOUCH stalked the pace while never far back, rallied into the stretch, took the lead mid stretch, was headed but came again gamely to prevail in a long drive. HEATHER ON was in a good stalking position in mid pack, rallied into the stretch, led briefly late but was outfinished to the wire. MISS DUSTY set the pace to late stretch while saving ground, gave way late but grudgingly. MISS DENZIL was unhurried early, had a mild rally but was too late. INDY ANNIE was unhurried early, had a mild rally late but was no factor. BOULE BABETTE showed good early speed while racing on the outside, faltered in the stretch and faded late. TOP ROMAN showed brief speed while up close early, gave way and dropped back. GREAT MT. failed to menace. SEMINOLE ROSE hit the rail hard while in tight, was pulled up and vanned off.
