CHASE THE BLAZE dueled for the lead and set the pace, responded when asked in the stretch and was all out to prevail in a long drive. LIFEINTHETROPICS pressed the pace and dueled for the lead, could not get by the winner late but gave way grudgingly. DANCING LOGO was void of early speed, rallied into the stretch and loomed a threat, failed to sustain the bid and an evenly late. PRIZE MONEY dueled for the lead and set the pace, weakened after a half mile and dropped back. POTENTIAL was void of early speed, rallied into the stretch, flattened out and ran evenly late. OUR TWO failed to menace. PROMISE HER DAMOON showed good early speed, was through after half mile and dropped back. STACK TOUR was no factor. CAMP CHINA flashed brief speed before stopping.
